No. of Scholarships

There is no cap on the number of scholarships, all the eligible students can avail the scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

All the **existing and newly admitted students** of following classes can apply:

- **Academic Category**
 - Class VI, VII, VIII
 - Class IX, X, XI and XII across State and ICSE/ ISC board
- **Non – Academic Category**
 - Exceptionally Talented Students in areas of performing arts, sports etc.
- **Special Category**
 - Other Candidates – Wards of Armed forces, Police, Direct Descendents of freedom fighters, Wards of Physically handicapped parents (divyangs)

Category: Academics

A) Automatic Qualification: Marks in Board Examinations

B) Scholarship Test: For students who do not meet the automatic eligibility criteria based on result of Board Exams, can still avail of scholarship by clearing the scholarship test. The grades obtained on the scholarship test as per the Table A below will determine the award / non-award & amount of scholarship

Category: Non- Academic

Scholarships can be awarded to exceptionally talented deserving candidates with demonstrated / proven credentials in the areas of performing arts, sports etc.

The scholarship is awarded subject to candidate producing original certificates / citations from recognized organization/ governing body in the area.

Category: Special

Wards of Armed forces, Police, COVID -19 Warriors, Direct Descendents of freedom fighters, Wards of Physically handicapped parents (Divyangs) will be given a special scholarship of **10% Waiver of Tuition Fees** subject to verification of credentials of the parents

Application Process

- A) Interested students can apply for the scholarship through the following:

- a. Fill up the online application form available at www.townhallschool.com/scholarship

- B) For New Admissions, purchase of **Admission Form** is a prerequisite for initiating the scholarship application review. An admission form fee is non-refundable irrespective of the scholarship being awarded.
- C) Candidates will be notified about the following:
 - a. Decision on award of scholarship if the automatic eligibility criterion is met.
 - b. In case an automatic eligibility criterion is not met, candidates will be notified about the date of Scholarship test.
 - c. In case of Non-academic or special category, candidates will be notified about the decision of award of scholarship subject to review of documents supporting the case.

Terms & Conditions

Continuation of scholarship from the current to next academic year is conditional on following:

- a) Maintaining 90% attendance at all times
- b) For academic scholarships maintaining grades in all Internal and Board Examinations
- c) Maintaining discipline and ensuring good & proper conduct at all times
